SAFETY AND SECURITY MEASURES IN THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

Bhawanipur Global Campus (An Autonomous Institution) places utmost importance on ensuring a safe, secure and supportive environment for all students, faculty members, staff and visitors. A multi-layered safety framework, supported by proper infrastructure, trained personnel and institutional policies, ensures that the campus remains conducive to academic growth and personal well-being.

➤ Campus Surveillance and Monitoring.

A network of more than 500 high-resolution CCTV cameras is installed across key locations such as entrances, corridors, classrooms, laboratories, libraries, parking areas, playgrounds and common spaces. Continuous monitoring by designated staff enhances vigilance and ensures timely intervention whenever required.



➤ Security Personnel and Gate Control.

Trained security guards are stationed at all entry and exit points to regulate visitor movement and prevent unauthorized access. Visitor logs, Student ID verification (digitalized) and vehicle entry checks are mandatory procedures. Security teams conduct periodic patrolling both day and night to maintain discipline and safety across the campus.

➤ **Fire Safety Systems**

The college is equipped with fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, fire alarms, sprinklers, hydrant systems, and clearly marked emergency exits. Fire Safety Certificates are obtained regularly, and fire-drills and evacuation exercises are conducted to strengthen preparedness among students and staff.



➤ **Emergency Response Mechanisms**

Emergency contact numbers of the families of students and staff, first-aid kits, and medical support systems are readily accessible. The institution has access to nearby hospitals for immediate assistance. Faculty and staff are trained in basic first aid and emergency response protocols.



➤ **Women Safety and Redressal Systems**

The college has functional committees such as the **Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)** and **Grievance Redressal Cell**, ensuring prompt redressal of issues related to women's safety and gender sensitivity. Well-lit pathways, CCTV surveillance, secure washrooms, and anti-harassment awareness programs further strengthen safety for women on campus.

➤ **Disaster Management and Evacuation Plan**

The College maintains a well-structured disaster management plan that includes evacuation routes, assembly points, electrical safety protocols and immediate response procedures for natural or accidental emergencies. Mock drills enhance readiness and coordination.

➤ **Health and Well-Being Support**

Campus health center/first-aid room trained medical staff (where applicable), psychological counselling services and wellness sessions contribute to the physical and emotional safety of learners. Sensitization programs on mental health, substance abuse and safety awareness are conducted regularly.

➤ **Infrastructure Safety**

The college ensures regular building inspections, electrical audits, equipment maintenance, and laboratory safety protocols. Hazardous materials in laboratories are handled as per safety guidelines with proper signage and protective equipment.
