POTABLE WATER SUPPLY

Bhawanipur Global Campus (An Autonomous Institution) ensures the provision of safe, clean, and uninterrupted potable water to all students, faculty members, staff, and visitors across the campus. Reliable access to drinking water is an essential component of a healthy learning environment, and the institution has implemented a well-structured water supply and purification system aligned with public health standards.

To guarantee water quality, the campus is equipped with RO (Reverse Osmosis) purification units, water filters, and UV-treated systems installed at multiple points such as academic buildings, laboratories, library, cafeteria, and administrative offices. These units undergo **periodic maintenance, cleaning, and filter replacement** to maintain optimum performance. Water samples are tested regularly to ensure compliance with safety norms and potable water standards.

Water dispensers and drinking water stations are strategically placed at accessible locations for the convenience of students and staff. Each station includes stainless steel fixtures and hygienic arrangements to prevent contamination. Boards indicating "Drinking Water" are displayed for clarity and proper usage. In addition, the college ensures adequate storage capacity with overhead tanks (21,000 Ltrs) and ground-level reservoirs (11,000 Ltrs), supported by routine inspections to prevent leakage or stagnation.

The institution also promotes environmental responsibility by encouraging the use of personal water bottles and reducing dependency on disposable plastic.

With a strong commitment to health, safety and sustainability, the College ensures that potable water supply remains uninterrupted, hygienic, and accessible to everyone on campus.
